How to make a Bushcraft Bracelet

1 Measure around your wrist



2 Fold your paracord in half. Pass the centre through your buckle



4 And pull through

3 Feed the two ends up through this loop





5 Feed the two ends up through the other end of the buckle (Make sure the buckle is the right way around!) Measure the cord length to match your wrist size, just the cord, ignore the buckle.

This one is 18 cm.

NOTE – Make sure you keep the central pair flat, not twisted from now on.

Tie a square knot as below




7 Bend the left hand end underneath the central pair and up through the right hand loop.

6 pass the right hand string over the central pair, then lay the left hand end over the top.




8 Pull this tight.



9 Do this again but lay the left over the top first instead of the right



10 Pull tight again



11

11 Repeat from step 6 and keep going

Turning at the end



13 pull the ends through



15 And keep going

12 Pass one end up through the buckle and pass the other end down through the buckle.



14 Start square knotting back the other way.



Finishing off



16 Pass both ends up through the buckle from the inside of the bracelet to the outside.

17 Loosen the last two knots and then pass the two ends up through these two knots.



18 Pull everything tight



19 Cut off the ends



20 Carefully melt the ends to seal them.
